

## HANBURY BOTANICAL GARDENS ESSENTIAL INFORMATION FOR VISITING AND SAFETY

Welcome,

you are about to start an itinerary inside a historic garden.

We invite you to enjoy the beauty of nature and architecture and we suggest you some precautions.

The difference in height from the entrance to the sea is over 100 meters, you will walk along partly sunny avenues and paths, some of which with stone floors, suitable shoes are recommended.

For users with reduced mobility, it is possible to avoid the stairs by using alternative paths.

An equipped electric car is available upon reservation.

Guide dogs are allowed in the gardens; water is available upon request at the ticket office and at the refreshment point. Other pets are not allowed and can be accommodated in an area dedicated to them, by contacting the ticket office.

The stretch of sea in front of the garden, called the Marine Protection Area of Capo Mortola, is accessible only via a bumpy footpath immediately downstream from the main entrance to the garden (Discesa del Marinaio).

Please pay attention to the walkways undergoing restoration in some areas, and to the plants and shrubs, not always known to everyone, sometimes thorny, sometimes stinging, which we invite you not to touch or collect. It is forbidden to enter the flower beds

The water of the fountains is not drinkable.

It is possible to drink the water from the taps of the toilet sinks.

For your safety, **five workstations** with **AED** (Semiautomatic External Defibrillator) devices have been installed at the **reception**, at the bottom of the first flight of stairs on the right (**Bookshop**), immediately after the bridge that crosses **via Romana**, at the **bar** near the sea and inside the **Villa** (the main Palace).

For the same reasons you will find fire hoses and hydrants, signposted along the way

Smoking is prohibited inside the garden.

Emergency exits are always indicated along the routes.

The toilets are located next to the reception, at the bottom of the first flight of stairs on the right (Bookshop), immediately after the bridge that crosses via Romana, at the bar near the sea.
